If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Butterfly Conservation will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Butterfly Conservation to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request. If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Butterfly Conservation or your bank or building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. If you receive a refund that you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Butterfly Conservation asks you to. You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.





The European Butterflies Group works to:

- Circulate information on European butterflies and moths to members and also to partners in Europe.
- Encourage recording of butterflies across Europe, facilitate contact with recording schemes and encourage production of local atlases that are planned in several parts of Europe.
- Publicise the plight of butterflies and moths, which face threats such as habitat destruction, land abandonment and climate change.
- Help set up projects with partners in other European countries.
- Provide a skilled volunteer resource for European nature conservation organisations and national parks.
- Facilitate activities outside the UK in which members can participate in survey and monitoring work and help members improve their skills in identifying butterflies.
- Assist the work of Butterfly Conservation Europe (BC Europe) and act as ambassadors for BC with partner organisations.
- Support partner organisations in lobbying in Europe.

As a member of Butterfly Conservation's European Butterflies Group (EBG) you will receive regular email newsletters and updates about conservation in Europe.

Membership of the EBG is open to all existing and new members of Butterfly Conservation for an additional cost of £10 per year. This additional payment will be taken at the same time as your main subscription so EBG membership will be free until your next BC subscription payment. To reduce administration costs, payment by direct debit is required for EBG membership.
